Genesis and Evolution of the School

The discipline of public health protects and improves the health of individuals and communities through various approaches such as the promotion of healthy behaviours, prevention and control of diseases, carrying out research in the field of health, and bringing policy changes through this research. Given the interdisciplinarity of the field, it brings together people from diverse backgrounds and perspectives to discover the origins of health problems and give solutions that are practical, feasible, and legitimate. The field of public health becomes relevant more in the post-pandemic world where the debates are centered around making the health systems resilient in case of future health emergencies on global as well as local levels. An improvement in the health of the individuals impacts the social as well as economic development of the countries leading to increased productivity, reduced absenteeism, and stimulating innovative approaches to health and healthcare.

With the globe facing unprecedented health challenges of a perilous nature, eventually, the need to create a public health workforce becomes extremely relevant. The leadership of the DY Patil deemed to be University, Navi Mumbai to translate this growing need for public health professionals envisioned the School of Public Health. With the drive and foresight to provide academically yet socially relevant training to public health professionals, the school came into being in the year 2021. The school aims to build a well-trained and skilled public health workforce capable of providing the required expertise in catering to equitable approaches to health and healthcare taking into consideration the variations within and across populations; locally as well as globally.

The School currently offers two PG programmes [Master of Public Health (MPH) and Master of

Public Policy (MPP)] and two UG programmes [Bachelor of Public Health (BPH) & Bachelor of

Environment & Sustainability (BSc ES)] in addition to PhD in public health related areas

School Development plan for the next three years

During the initial two years of its existence the school primarily went through a phase of

consolidation wherein the focus was on identifying the strength and enabling factors. Focus was

on fine tuning the curriculum and strengthening collaborations. Consequently, a strong globally

relevant curriculum has been put in place and reputed, competent faculty have been recruited. The

school has also forged meaningful collaborations and is an active member of the Public Health

Consortium with IIPHG, AIIMS J, Datta Meghe, and Parul University and the Cancer Consortium

with University of Kentucky, MAHE & Tata Memorial Centre. Academic and research partnership

with McGill University, Canada, has resulted in two ongoing research projects and an innovative

scholar in residence initiative.
